IPT updates from IPTuk Chair Marie Wardle and IPTuk Deputy Chair Jane Taylor

Marie and Jane updated the conference on:

IPT group training;

IPT for PTSD and 2 RCTs currently underway and would be first therapy to offer non-exposure work for PTSD. Still early days but is a promising development; National Strategy and NICE guidelines.

Presentation 1:

Dr Jamie Barsky delivered a session on the IPT AST model for young persons, a skills based and preventative group training for younger persons at risk of developing depression. Jamie explained it has been downgraded in the NICE guidelines and should be offered where CBT is not indicated.

Fiona Duffy is currently conducting a research meta-analysis.

This was a really useful introduction to this approach and, as Jamie pointed out, the principles and skills within this approach can be used with adults too.

Presentation 2:

Angela Wood, Interpersonal Therapist with Pennine Care, delivered her informative and interactive "Delivering IPT with a Perinatal Frame of Mind".

Presentation 3:

Dr Jennie Stanford presented her very interesting introductory presentation on Interpersonal and Social Rhythm Therapy and its use as a treatment for bipolar disorder.
