

Membership and Website Update

Membership:

- 745 members in total; since May 2018, we have had 143 new members

Website:

- New regional resources since May 2018:

Accreditation certificates

- Following our previous network meeting, all accreditation certificates have been backdated and issued for those whose membership has been renewed. This came to a total of 236 members.
- We now have a system in place for issuing these on a rolling basis; once per month, JA is issuing accreditation certificates for those who have renewed their membership over the previous four-week period.

Future ideas for the website:

- Website redesign in process; in particular, increasing the functionality of the IPT register (e.g. search function by region)

Membership/website issues and how we are rectifying them:

- We noticed that some members had created duplicate PaySubsOnline accounts (e.g. one for trainee membership, and one for post-qualification membership), which affected the accuracy of our membership numbers
 - JA has amalgamated all duplicate accounts
- Some members' IPT UK accreditation has expired and their names are still on the register/ mailing list
 - JA is working through a list of those who are behind on renewal payments. At present, 15 have been contacted (out of 97), and are given the opportunity to renew their accreditation pending fulfilment of our CPD requirements
