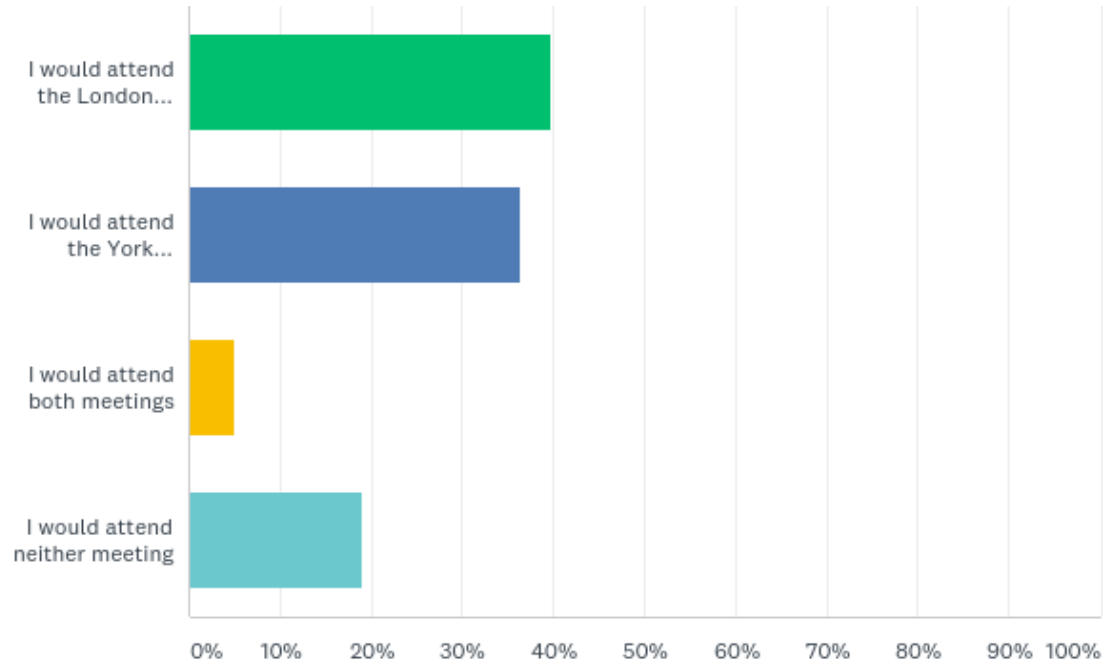

Q1: Earlier this year, some of our members told us that they find it difficult to attend national network events in London. One possible solution to this would be to hold one of our two national meetings in York. Q. If, in 2018, we held one meeting in London and one in York, which of these (if any) would you attend?

The majority of respondents told us that they would only attend the location closest to them, or would not attend either:

“These meetings are not close to my location and its difficult being reimbursed for travel to meetings, that far”

“York is more easily accessible.”

“Due to time and distance, London is easier to travel to”

Only a minority said that they would welcome the meetings across two locations to try to even out the travel burden for members:

“This seems fair. Please provide plenty of advance notice on which meeting will begin which venue to allow time to book travel.”

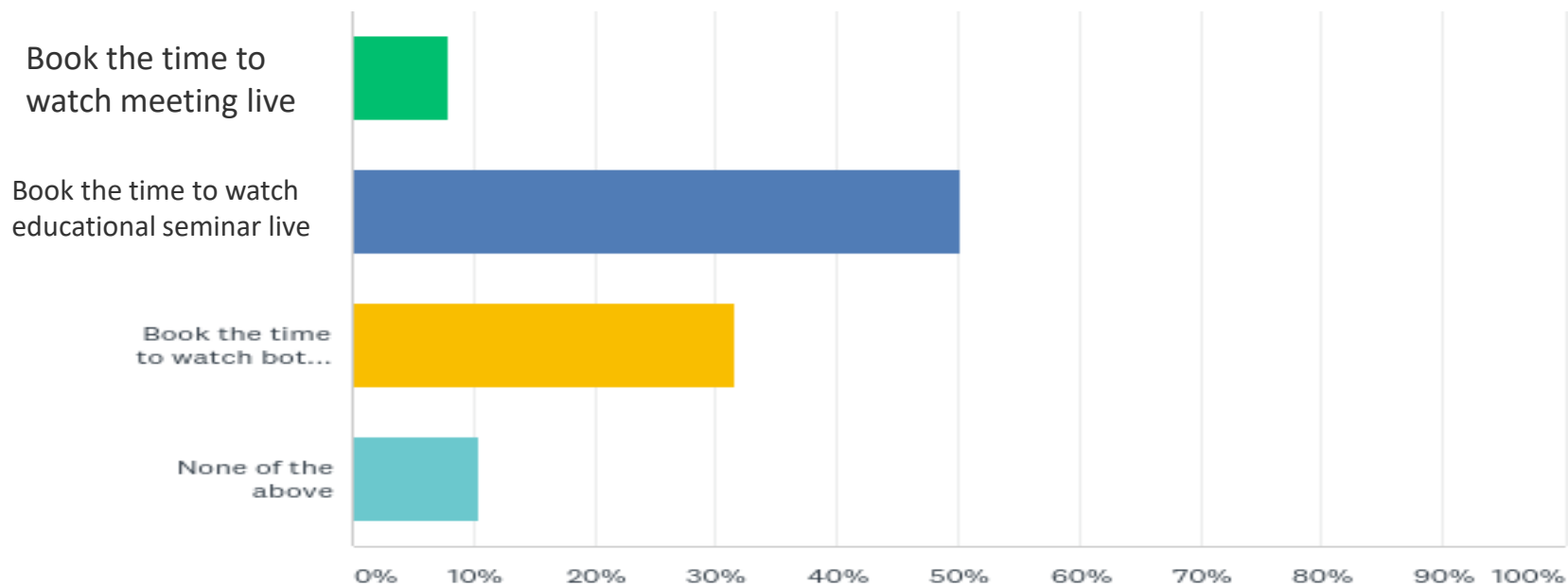
For discussion:

As members generally preferred to go to the location nearest to them, or suggested locations even nearer to where they live (e.g. Edinburg, midlands), it seems that adding locations wouldn't increase the overall attendance at each meeting, but might mean that more people overall would attend at least one.

- **Question: On this basis, do we want to agree to continue as is, or move one meeting a year to a Northern location?**

Q2: Some members have asked if we could live stream the business meeting and educational seminar to make them more accessible to members based outside of London.Q. If we were able to live stream the educational seminar and business meeting online via our website, would you:

This would be a big piece of work but potentially popular with members.

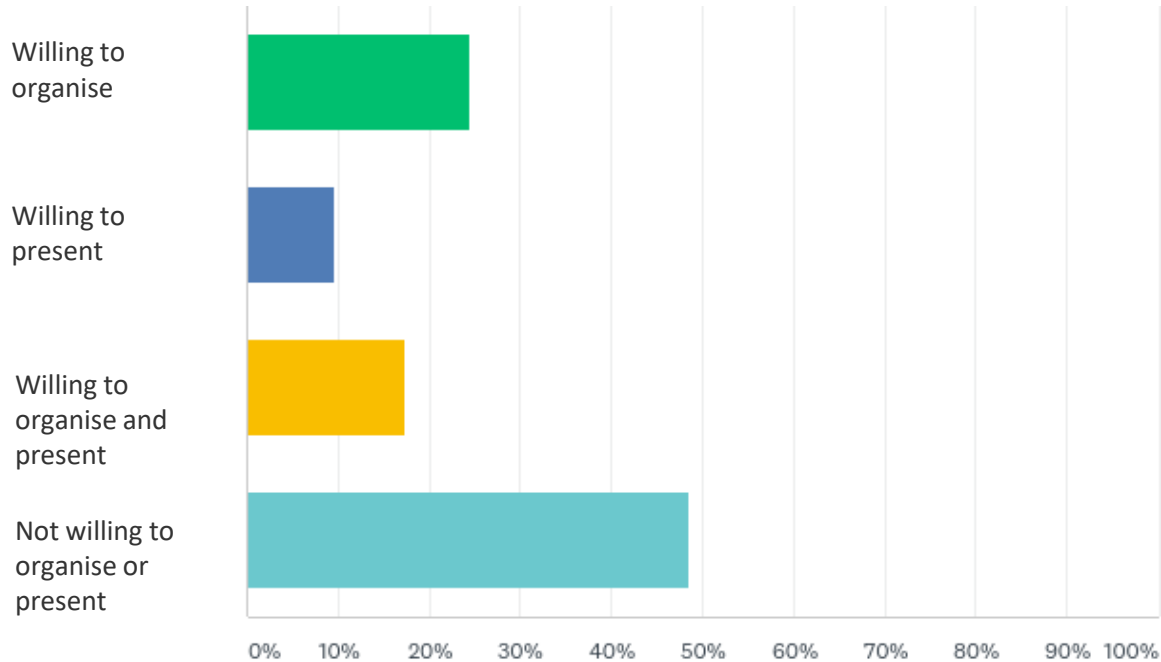
What would be involved?

When could we aim to have this running?

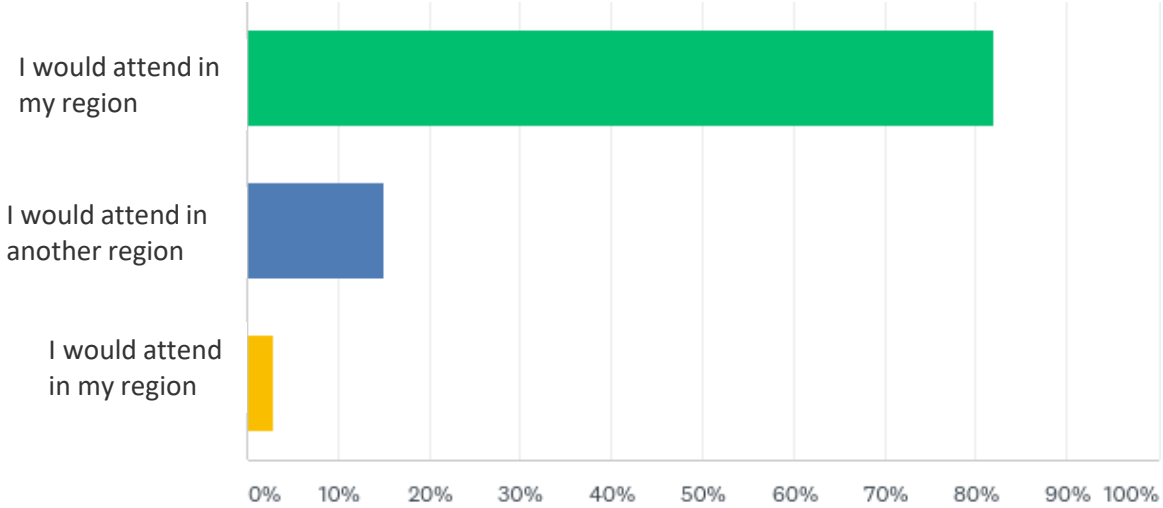

Conclusions

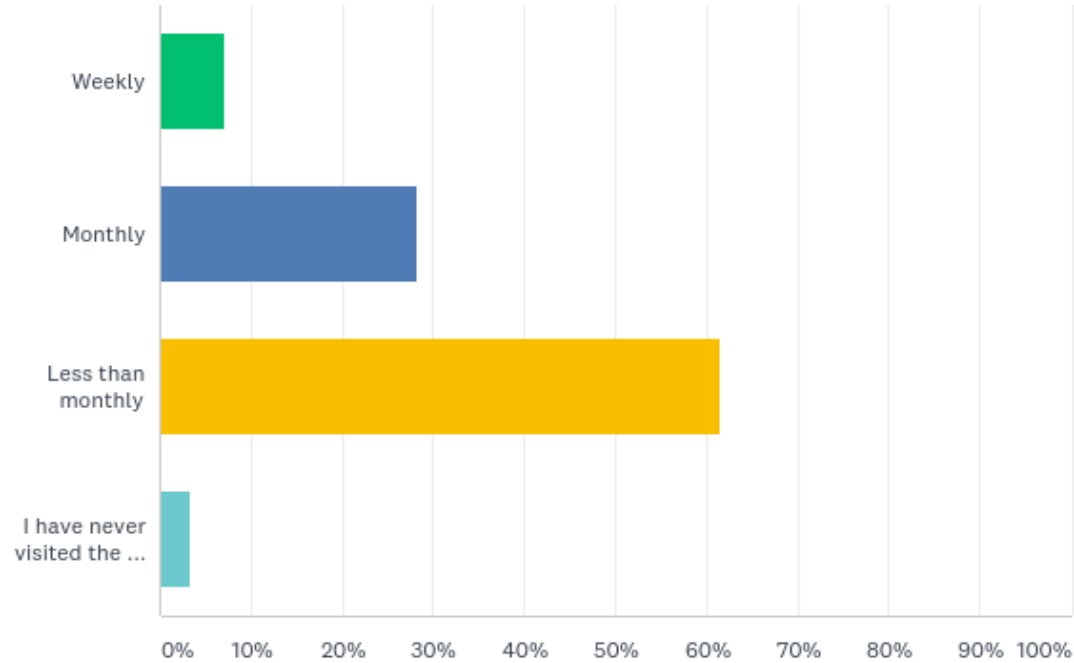
Again there was an overwhelming preference for members to only attend events close to home. This is understandable given lack of funding for training expenses but would call the success of a national conference into question.

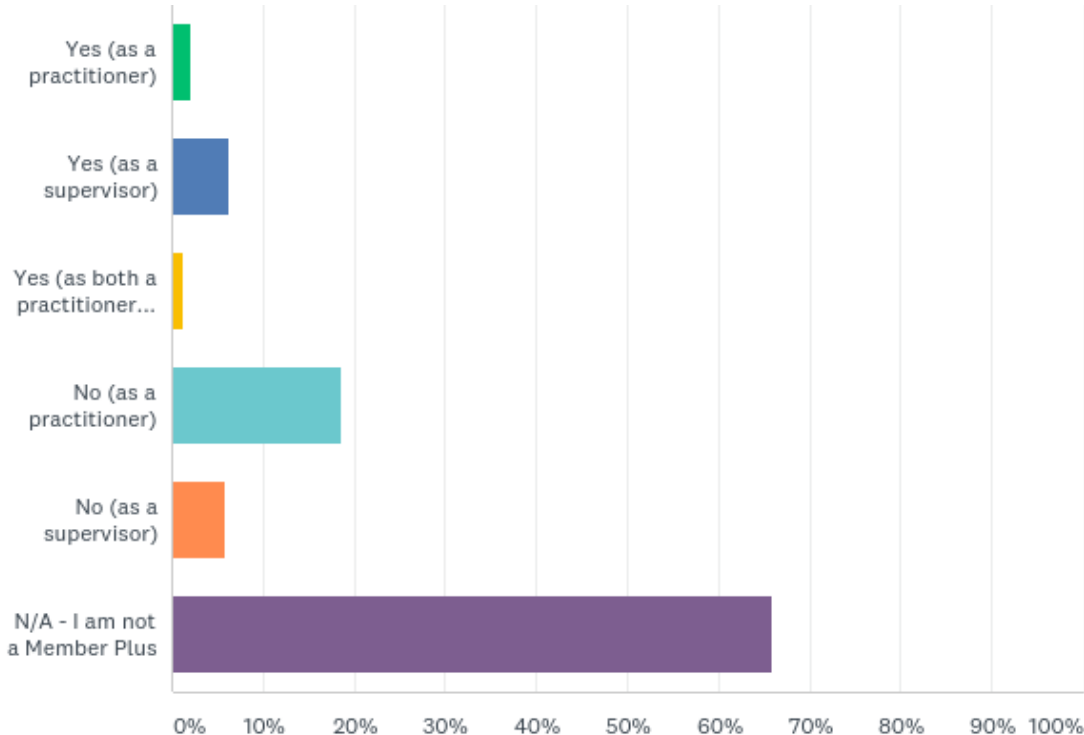
Q5: Approximately how often do you visit the IPT UK website?

Answered: 241 Skipped: 1



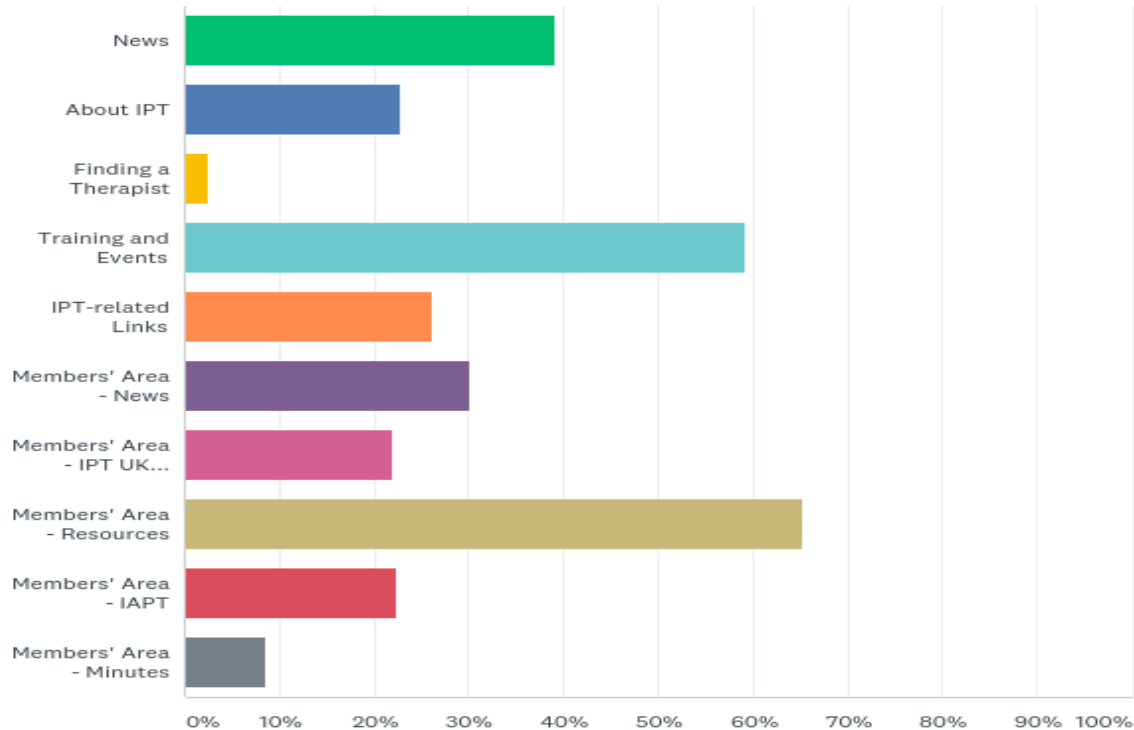
